Compiled exclusively for members of The Cheryl Wheeler Mailing List Two things are true: songwriters with record contracts do not record every song they write or perform; and fans of those performing songwriters often bring tape recorders to gigs. In Cheryl Wheeler's case, the intersection of these truths occurs on these discs. Cheryl has written and performed hundreds of songs during her 30-year career, and though she has seven albums to her credit, many of the incredible songs she plays at her concerts have not found their way onto a record. Fortunately, plenty of her shows have been recorded by audience members or from the soundboard.

In 2003, Cheryl gave members of The Cheryl Wheeler Mailing List (a fanrun Internet discussion group) permission to distritube a collection of songs that had been recorded live, but never released on a commercial album. The only condition she imposed was that it be distributed **only** to members of the mailing list, andthat it be available at no charge. The result is *No Previous Record*, a 2-disc album spanning 26 years of writing and performance.

The project got its start when Bill Pringle put together a disc containing songs that Cheryl had played in concert during the past 15 years. He hoped to convince Cheryl to consider recording some of them for a future album. When Cheryl and her manager agreed that the disc Bill made could be distributed to members of the mailing list, Shelly Brisbin, who runs the list, volunteered to reorganize the songs, add some more, and clean up the recordings. When Bill began sending more tapes and CDs, Shelly realized that one disc would not suffice. Cheryl soon took a personal interest in the project, contributing her own tapes, and working with Shelly to choose the best songs.

The 52 songs on *No Previous Recor∂* were recorded in theaters, bars, cafes, churches and radio studios all over the country. The oldest tape comes from 1977; the most recent recording was made while this project was underway, in April 2003. Some recordings are great: some are not, but all are the best available.
